

VILLAGE OF EMPRESS
Bylaw Number 14-2020

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF EMPRESS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC ROAD TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the road closed, and

WHEREAS the original road allowance has not been developed or used for public travel, nor will these lands be required for public streets or other public purposes in the foreseeable future, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Empress deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel, certain roads or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, disposing of same, and thereafter consolidating with the adjacent property, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Empress held a public Hearing at their regular Council meeting of December 17, 2020

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Empress is satisfied that closing this portion of the original road allowance will not adversely affect the traffic flow or prejudicially affect the public at large,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Empress in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of disposing of the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

East West alley located north of lots 10-20 Block 27 Plan 5043AV as well as between lots 6-10 and lots 21-26 Block 27 Plan 5043AV.
