BY-LAW No.5-2021

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE EMPRESS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL
BYLAW 9-63**

WHEREAS, pursuant the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete and superseded bylaws of the Village of Empress;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Empress assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as "Repeal Bylaw 9-63 Bylaw".
2. THAT Bylaw #9-63, being the Empress Traffic Bylaw, be repealed as it is outdated and no longer deemed necessary to Village operations.
3. THAT the repeal date of the above Bylaw be the date of final passage of this Bylaw.
4. THAT this bylaw shall continue in full force and effect in perpetuity.

Read a first time this 15th day of April, 2021.

Read a second time this 15th day of April, 2021.

Given unanimous consent to proceed to third and final reading this 15th day of April, 2021.

Read a third time and finally passed this 15th day of April, 2021.
