BY-LAW No.5-2021

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE EMPRESS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTATO REPEAL BYLAW 9-63

WHEREAS, pursuant the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete and superseded bylaws of the Village of Empress;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Empress assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw shall be known as "Repeal Bylaw 9-63 Bylaw".
- 2. THAT Bylaw #9-63, being the Empress Traffic Bylaw, be repealed as it is outdated and no longer deemed necessary to Village operations.
- 3. THAT the repeal date of the above Bylaw be the date of final passage of this Bylaw.
- 4. THAT this bylaw shall continue in full force and effect in perpetuity.

Read a second time this 15th day of April, 2021.

Given unanimous consent to proceed to third and final reading this 15th day of April, 2021.

Read a third time and finally passed this 15th day of April, 2021.
