

VILLAGE OF EMPRESS

BYLAW NO. 3 - 2001

ASSESSOR AS DESIGNATED OFFICER

Being a Bylaw of the Village of Empress, in the province of Alberta, to establish the position of Assessor of the Village of Empress as a Designated Officer.

Whereas the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994, chapter M-26.1, as amended, came into force on January 1, 1995;

And Whereas Section 210 of the Act allows a Council to pass a bylaw establishing a position to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer;

And Whereas Council wishes to establish the position of Assessor as a designated officer under Section 284.1 (d) of the Act;

Now Therefore the Council of the Village of Empress enacts the following:

1. Council hereby establishes the position of Assessor for the village of Empress as a designated officer.
2. The assessor must meet the qualifications set out in the regulations to carry out the duties of an assessor as defined in the Municipal Government Act.
3. This bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading.

Read a first time this 31st day of **May, 2001**.

Read a second time this 31st day of **May, 2001**.

Read a third time and finally passed this 31st day of **May, 2001**.
