VILLAGE OF EMPRESS

BYLAW NO. 3 - 2001

ASSESSOR AS DESIGNATED OFFICER

Being a Bylaw of the Village of Empress, in the province of Alberta, to establish the position of Assessor of the Village of Empress as a Designated Officer.

Whereas the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994, chapter M-26.1, as amended, came into force on January 1, 1995;

And Whereas Section 210 of the Act allows a Council to pass a bylaw establishing a position to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer;

And Whereas Council wishes to establish the position of Assessor as a designated officer under Section 284.1 (d) of the Act;

Now Therefore the Council of the Village of Empress enacts the following:

- Council hereby establishes the position of Assessor for the village of Empress as a designated officer.
- 2. The assessor must meet the qualifications set out in the regulations to carry out the duties of an assessor as defined in the Municipal Government Act.
- 3. This bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading.
