BY-LAW No.12-2014

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE AMENDMENT OF BYLAW 6-2014

WHEREAS the Village of Empress has noted an error in the Tax Bylaw 6-2014 part 2. for minimum tax rates;

AND WHEREAS the Village wishes to ensure taxation rates are applied fairly to all properties;

NOW THEREFORE under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Empress authorizes the amendment of Bylaw 6-2012 section 2 to read as follows:

2. The remaining Municipal taxes will be collected pursuant to Part 10, Division 2 of the Municipal Government Act a minimum amount payable as property tax shall be applied as follows:

	<u>Minimum Levy Amount</u>
Residential improvements and land at or over an assessed value of \$20,139.16 and up to an assessed value of \$46,450.	\$ 785.07
Residential improvements, land and farmland Between the assessed value of \$10,069.58 and \$20,139.16	\$ 340.38
Residential vacant land & or with outbuildings Assessed value below \$10,069.58	\$ 170.19
Residential vacant land & farmland	\$ 170.19
Non-residential improvements and land at or over an assessed value of \$12,763.99 and up to an assessed value of \$29,439.54	\$ 785.07
Non-residential improvements and land Between the assessed value of \$8,646.58 and \$12,763.99	\$ 340.38
Non-Residential vacant land & or with outbuildings Assessed value below \$8,646.58	\$ 230.58
Non-residential vacant properties	\$ 230.58

3. That this by-law shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.
