**BY-LAW No. 2022-02**

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE EMPRESS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAW 1-2019**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

**WHEREAS**, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete and superseded bylaws of the Village of Empress;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Empress assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as "Repeal Bylaw 1-2019 Bylaw".
2. THAT Bylaw #1-2019, being the Sidewalk & Boulevard Maintenance Bylaw, be repealed as it is no longer deemed necessary to Village operations.
3. THAT the repeal date of the above Bylaw be the date of final passage of this Bylaw.
4. THAT this bylaw shall continue in full force and effect in perpetuity.

Read a first time this 17th day of February, 2022.

Read a second time this 19th day of October, 2022.

Read a third time and finally passed this 19th day of October, 2022.
