

VILLAGE OF EMPRESS

BYLAW NO. 4- 2001 ESTABLISH PENALTIES ON UNPAID PROPERTY TAXES

Being A Bylaw of the Village of Empress, in the province of Alberta, to establish penalties on unpaid property taxes.

Whereas the Municipal Government Act, of the province of Alberta provides that a Municipal council may establish penalties on property taxes.

Now Therefore the Council of the Village of Empress duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That a penalty of twelve (12%) percent shall be added and payable on all unpaid current taxes on the 31st day from the date of the mailing of the tax notices.
2. That a penalty of twelve (12%) percent shall be added to all tax arrears on January 1st of each year.

Read a first this 31st day of **May, 2006**.

Read a second this 31st day of **May, 2006**.

Read a third time and finally passed this 31st day of **May, 2006**.
