BY-LAW No.6-2018

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE EMPRESS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA. TO REPEAL BYLAW 19-76

WHEREAS, pursuant the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete and superseded bylaws of the Village of Empress;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Empress assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as "Repeal Bylaw 19-76 Bylaw".
2. THAT Bylaw #19-76, Off Highways Vehicle Bylaw be repealed as it is no longer deemed necessary to Village operations.
3. THAT the repeal date of the above Bylaw be the date of final passage of this Bylaw.
4. THAT this bylaw shall continue in full force and effect in perpetuity.

Read a first time this 16th day of August, 2018.


Read a second time this 16th day of August, 2018.

Given unanimous consent to proceed to third and final reading this 16th day of August, 2018.

Read a third time and finally passed this 16th day of August, 2018.
